UPS REVEALS DATA BREACH

UPS is warning that subsidiary UPS Stores suffered a point-of-sale malware attack that compromised numerous card transactions over a seven-month period. All told, 51 of its U.S. franchised center locations across 24 states were infected, which may have resulted in attackers compromising customers' personal information and payment card details, including some Social Security and driver's license numbers, thus placing them at risk of identity theft and fraud. Two Tallahassee UPS stores are reported to have been affected.
